Topic - Elements of Public Administration

→ There are four elements of Public Administration -

1- Organisation - The principle element of Public Administration is Organisation through which it performs multiple functions. Without a well-settled organisation, Public Administration can not exist.

2 - Objective of Welfare - The main purpose of the

Public Administration is to establish a welfare state. By the help of welfare state, Public Administration extends several kinds of services to public like - To construct bridges, dams roads etc.

3- Authority - Authority empowers civil servants to execute properly the work of Public Administration. By using authority public servants legitimise their actions and coordinate with other public officials to implement government policies.

4- Broad base - The base of Public Administration is quite wide. The functions of all three branches of government the legislature, executive and judiciary fall in the realm of Public Administration.

5. Financial Power - Financial power is the integral element of Public Administration. From budget to other resources for the welfare of public lie down under the purview of Public Administration.
